1. Elections for the SCIE Chair and Vice-Chair will be held at the SCIE meeting in the spring with officers assuming duties at the beginning of the new Academic Year.
 - a. The current Executive Committee shall serve as a Nominations Committee for the purpose of recruiting nominees for the new SCIE positions to be elected in the spring.
 - b. The Nominations Committee shall present candidates for the positions at the spring meeting. Nominations may also be made from the floor.
 - c. Voting shall occur by silent, anonymous ballot during the spring SCIE meeting.
